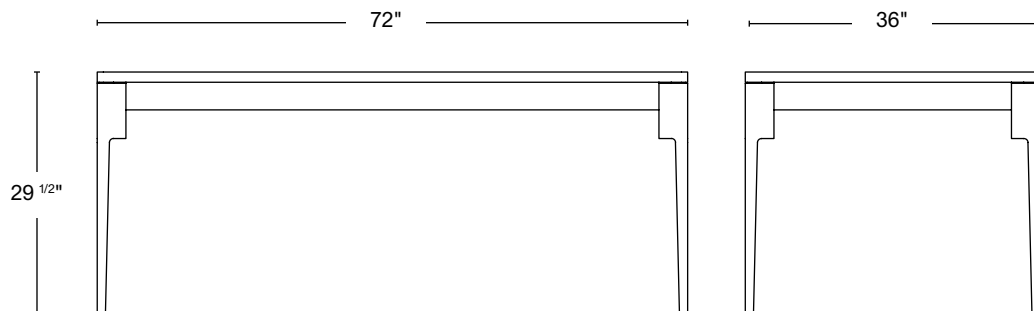

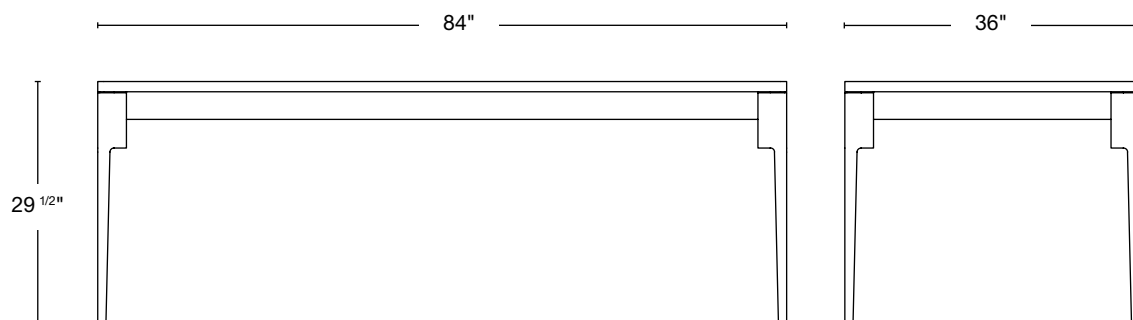
WOOD FINISH Natural walnut

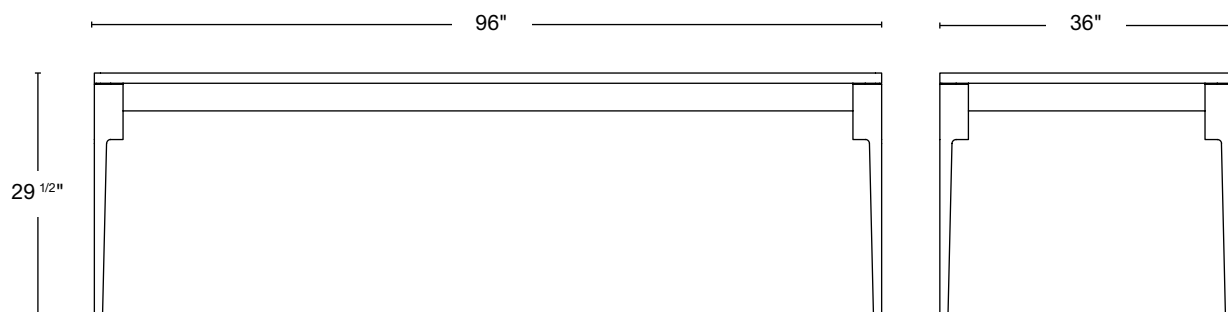
